


- Weatherization is a FREE program to you. Funded through The Department of Energy and The Department of Health and Human Services.
- A house can be weatherized one time every 15 years. If your home has had weatherization services within the past 15 years, it would not be eligible at this time.
- A household must be eligible for Energy Assistance program to qualify for Weatherization.
- The Weatherization assistance program goal is to reduce home energy costs by improving energy efficiency while ensuring Health and Safety.
- A trained housing inspector evaluates the home as a system comprised of the building structure, the mechanical systems, and the residents. Weatherization services include:
  - Energy conservation education
  - A home weatherization audit determines how to potentially save energy plus maintain the health and safety of the occupants of the home. Diagnostic testing will be performed on the house. The aim is to discover air leaks and pressure imbalances.



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## **Diagnostic Tools**

Testing the airtightness of a home using a special fan called a blower door can help to ensure that air sealing work is effective. Often, energy efficiency incentive programs, such as the DOE/ EPA ENERGY STAR Program, require a blower door test (usually performed in less than an hour) to confirm the tightness of the house.



#### Measures may include:

- Attic, wall, floor, and ceiling insulation, air infiltration and bypass sealing
- Test, repair, and/or replace home mechanical systems to ensure efficiency and safety.
- Final inspection to ensure all work is performed correctly and satisfactorily.

# The following repairs are NOT included in the weatherization program:

New roofing, windows, siding, foundation, plumbing or electrical. To inquire about our rehabilitation programs that include these items. Please contact United Community Action Partnerships Housing Department.
